# Introduction

IGNITE Worldwide (IGNITE) is the answer to achieving gender equity in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM). We work directly with educators during the school day to provide events that promote STEM education and career advancement for girls and gender-diverse youth, primarily from Title 1 Schools, rural, and tribal school communities.

The IGNITE Program inspires girls to take charge of their future by building self-confidence through hands-on activities and direct connections to STEM role models from their communities. Our one-of-a-kind events welcome students from all backgrounds to experience STEM first-hand by learning technical skills and being inspired by STEM professionals who look like them.

IGNITE was founded on the principles of supporting girls, girls of color, and gender-diverse students, as these students face the largest barriers to education and career exposure in STEM fields. By providing IGNITE Program events during the school day, IGNITE is able to reach under-resourced student groups, many of whom face obstacles to participating in after-school or summer programs because of transportation availability, obligations at home, and/or safety concerns.

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# IGNITE Program: 2024-2025 Event Offerings



The IGNITE Program is aligned with school curriculum and coordinated through Career and Technical Education (CTE) teachers at each school to help recruit and retain girls in STEM classes and clubs as a stepping stone to obtaining foundational skills and pursue high-wage, high-demand careers. These events are offered cost-free to schools and students during the school day, throughout the school year.



## Field Trip

- Behind-the-scenes look at STEM in action with an office tour and hands-on STEM activity
- Includes Panel (see above) and Q&A, facilitated by an IGNITE-trained educator or volunteer
- Available in select areas as an in-person event at a host company's workplace



## Workshop

- Features interactive, hands-on STEM activity
- Includes Panel (see left) and Q&A, facilitated by an IGNITE-trained educator or volunteer
- Available in select areas as in-person at-school event, or nationwide as virtual event



## Panel

- Featuring women and gender-diverse STEM professionals, representing different companies and industries
- Interactive Q&A where students ask their own questions directly to the panelists
- Scheduled on-demand via educator request
- Available in select areas as in-person at-school event, or nationwide as virtual event



## Specialized Offerings

- Show-and-Tell mini-panel for elementary school-aged students
- Conferences designed for postsecondary students and high school graduates
- Out-of-school programming for middle through high school students
- Mentoring for IGNITE Alumni

# IGNITE Program: Creating an Event at Your Company

**Your company decides the topic – be creative and have fun!**

IGNITE Partners work with their IGNITE Program Representative to design, develop, and publish their event. Partners determine the topic and activity, while IGNITE integrates IGNITE's best practices and collaborates on curriculum design. All events are led by a group of IGNITE-trained STEM professionals.

*All IGNITE Volunteers are provided training materials and those volunteers who serve as panelists complete the IGNITE Panelist Training and Coaching Sessions prior to their event.*

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## Posting & Registration

**We coordinate with the teachers; you work directly with the students.**

Through print and digital advertising, IGNITE supports the posting of your event so that it is as successful as possible. Each event is published on our website so that IGNITE Educators can easily view and register for the event.

*All IGNITE Educators complete the IGNITE Educator Training and are dedicated to introducing STEM or increasing engagement in STEM clubs and/or classes at their school. They recruit the students to attend your event, through the support of their IGNITE Program Representative.*

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## Engagement & Follow-Up

Every IGNITE Event receives a customized post-event reporting, so that you can hear directly from the students who participated in your event. This is a great way to celebrate your volunteers and your company's engagement and build momentum within your organization to plan your next event!

# Event Snapshot:

## IGNITE Field Trip with AWS

In October 2023, IGNITE Students from the West Valley Innovation Center were invited to participate in the first-ever AWS Youth Tech Day! The IGNITE Program Field Trip to the AWS Skills Center in Seattle was a collaborative effort between IGNITE Worldwide and Amazon Web Services (AWS). With 27 volunteers from AWS gathered to support the event and interact with the students, including inspiring Panelists Jaime Vest, Ming Huang, Leah Schultheis, and Maria Petrova and special guest Peter Cray, VP of Strategy and Operations, AWS Sales, Marketing, and Global Services.

The exciting atmosphere of the AWS Skills Center set the tone for the event, which featured a mix of STEM activities, including trivia and a block coding exercise that instructed students to animate characters dancing. One lucky student had their dance selected to be acted out by the AWS Volunteers and students! Throughout the day, students were encouraged to raise their hands and ask questions directly to the speaker, including whether diverse experiences impact one's career and if language barriers hinder success in the tech world.
