We work directly with educators during the school day to provide events that build confidence, explore STEM, and introduce pathways to high-wage, high-demand jobs. The IGNITE Program is intentionally designed to serve girls and gender-diverse students by creating a safe and empowering learning environment.

3-Year Collaborative Expansion Model

Launch Partnership

- Identify Expansion Community (geographic location)
- Define Funding Focus
- Chart Timeline & Roles
- \$75,000

Stage 1: Research and Development

- Identify community needs and inaugural school district
- Support workforce development by aligning program focus with local industries
- Build local IGNITE Ecosystem (schools, educators, volunteers)

Stage 2: Implementation (Phase 1)

- Introduce IGNITE in-person events (ie. field trips) to inaugural school
- Expand Event Host Company Partners
- \$50,000

Stage 3: Implementation (Phases 2-4)

- Widen school base (more IGNITE Chapters in more schools)
- Increase Program Event offerings (inc. Workshops, Panels)
- Secure additional host companies for sustainability
- \$50,000
